There were 3.9 million births in 2013

Medicaid covers nearly of all births

## **HEALTH EQUITY**

Community-based doulas reduce disparities by supporting women facing the greatest risks



The risk of maternal death is:



3 to 4x higher for black women compared to white women

Black women are

as likely to want, but not have. doula care compared to white women

#### **COST of CARE**

births is by cesarean



> 2x the 5-15% that the WHO recommends

Cesareans cost

> than vaginal births



Universal doula support

could reduce spending on cesareans by \$2.3 billion
